

Many people come to Puerto Rico for its beautiful beaches, **El Viejo San Juan**, **El Yunque**, and a few other national treasures, but today the focus will be on the city of **Fajardo** and the activities you can enjoy there. Located on the coast, **Las Croabas** is home to a variety of restaurants next to its passive park, such as **El Trasmallo**, **Café Playero**, and **El Pescador**, among others.

Within the vicinity of the park, there's a kayak station offering tours of the bioluminescent bay in **Las Croabas**. You can visit during the day, but to truly witness the full splendor of the bioluminescent lights, it's most recommended to go after sundown.

Not too far down the road, you'll find one of the most well-known beaches in Puerto Rico, **Seven Seas Beach**, which is almost always packed with crowds.

Just a short walk from the beach, there's also a water park for those who prefer a quick splash or want to spend some time in non-salty water, enjoying slides and other attractions, especially suited for kids. If hunger strikes, you can head across the street through a gate entrance, where you'll find several food trucks offering a variety of food and treats.

For those who love burgers, along the way to the **passive park**, you'll pass a gas station, and right next to it is a place called **Burger Lab**, which serves some of the best and biggest burgers in Puerto Rico.

If you're looking to celebrate an occasion, there's an establishment called **Club Aries**, where you can rent the space and decorate it as you see fit. Inside, the establishment is quite spacious, and outside, you'll find a large swimming pool, a beautiful green area, and plenty of parking space.
